Profession of Faith: (Nicene Creed)

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen and unseen. We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten not made, one in Being with the Father. Through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation, he came down from heaven; by the power of the Holy Spirit he was born of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered, died and was buried. On the third day he rose again in fulfillment of the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the Giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the Prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

AFFIRMATION SET FOR JULY 15TH

As reported previously, both the Call Committee and the Parish Council voted favorably in early June to hire Fr. Teri for the LOC Pastor position. On July 15, the congregation will be asked to support and affirm this decision with a simple vote of support following the 5:00 PM liturgy. The Call Committee will facilitate this process using a streamlined ballot listing a yes/no option only which will be quickly tallied and the results will be announced immediately. The LOC Bylaws state: **A simple majority vote of affirmation of attending registered members is required.** Please plan to attend and participate. Your affirmation is an opportunity to support the positive direction and renewed vitality of the LOC community.



If any parishioner knows that they will not be able to attend the short meeting on Saturday evening, July 15th, and they wish to express their position for or against affirmation of Fr. Teri as Pastor, they may send a simple "Yes I favor Fr. Teri as Pastor", or "No, I do not favor Fr. Teri as Pastor" to callcommittee@lightofchristecc.org, and your vote will be counted along with those cast at the meeting. **Deadline for submission of an email affirmation is Friday, July 14 at noon.**
