## OUTREACH OPPORTUNITY

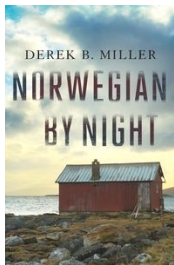

## BOOK DISCUSSION GROUP



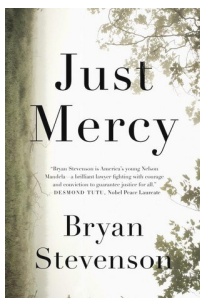
