- **The Earth Corner Challenge for March - Less is more:** Reading and listening to information about climate change and its dire consequences can be alarming. It can also be counterproductive because fear and anxiety cause us to freeze, to give up, rather than take action, says neuroscientist Tali Sharot. In this week's Earth Corner we suggest that we dump the scary stories and focus on things that work and what is most important to you. This week, ask yourself why climate change matters to you personally. Is it because it will mean a better future for your children and their children? Do you care about it because it will help keep our communities vital, stable, and healthy? What's in it for you? Earth Corner will continue to focus on the little things that may help in a big way bring down the earth's temperature.

Earth Corner Things to consider

- ⇒ Go meatless twice a week.
- ⇒ Reduce food waste.
- ⇒ Buy used items when feasible.
- ⇒ Recycle, reuse, or repurpose items.

- **COVID 19 guidelines:** To help keep everyone safe, the following guidelines have been developed by the BL/LOC Pandemic Advisory Group. The most recent changes are highlighted in **red** and reflect the changing dynamic of the outbreak and in light of new guidance from the CDC, state and local public health.
 - **Mass will be permitted in the sanctuary at this time**
 - People must sit using the quilts to help maintain social distancing.
 - **Masks must be worn for Mass in the sanctuary.**
 - **Indoor groups of less than 20 can decide at the time of meeting to be mask-optional.**
 - Groups will need to wipe down/sanitize after each meeting
 - **Masks are required for moving around the building.**
