## Earth Corner: Water is Health

**Our June topic is water.**

### Earth Corner Things to Consider

- ⇒ Fix water leaks.
- ⇒ Wash clothes in cold water.
- ⇒ Cut the length of showers.
- ⇒ Don't let water run, use only what you need, turn off the tap when brushing teeth.
- ⇒ Water gardens in the early morning or evening.
- ⇒ Use dishwashers not hand-washing.

All people need access to a steady source of quality drinking water. Children's health and security, in particular, depend on water that is free of contamination and pollutants. The United Nations has documented the impact of water scarcity on children worldwide and they say that climate change has made water availability unpredictable. Around 450 million children live in areas of high or extremely high water vulnerability. This means that they do not have enough water to meet their everyday needs. Every day, over 700 children under five die from diarrhea linked to inadequate water, sanitation, and hygiene.

Climate change exacerbates water stress—areas of extremely limited water resources—leading to increased competition for water, even conflict. By 2040, almost 1 in 4 children will live in areas of extremely high water stress.
